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Eligibility

SSVF is required to assess veteran families' eligibility using the following guidelines:



Veterans experiencing literal homelessness or imminent risk of homelessness

Active-duty military service with a discharge other than Dishonorable

Gross annual household income is less than 80% area median income

Resides in Santa Barbara County
